"I like the people I work with in my internship. I'm learning office skills and working on projects that are fulfilling. I'd recommend the MassHire Youth Works program to others."



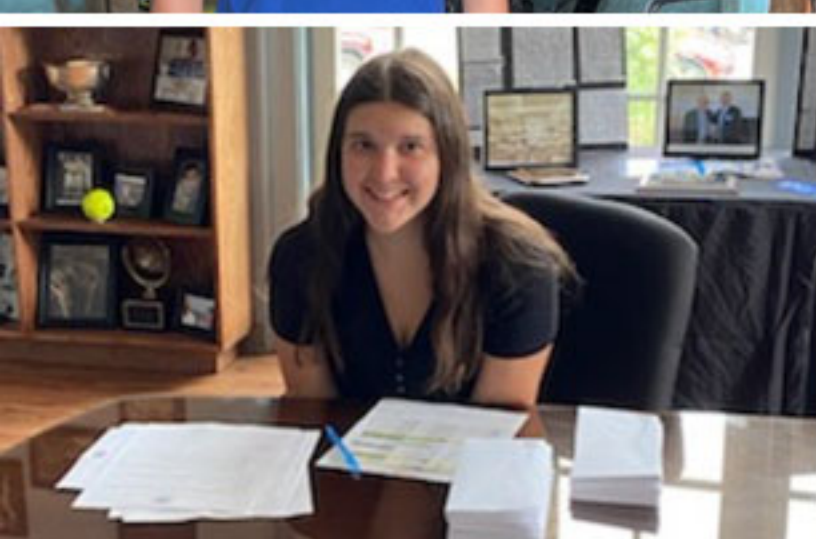

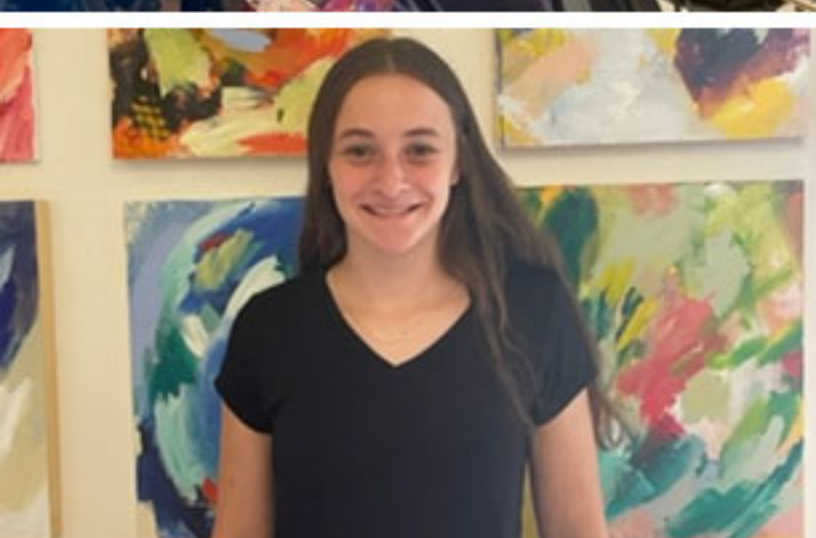
