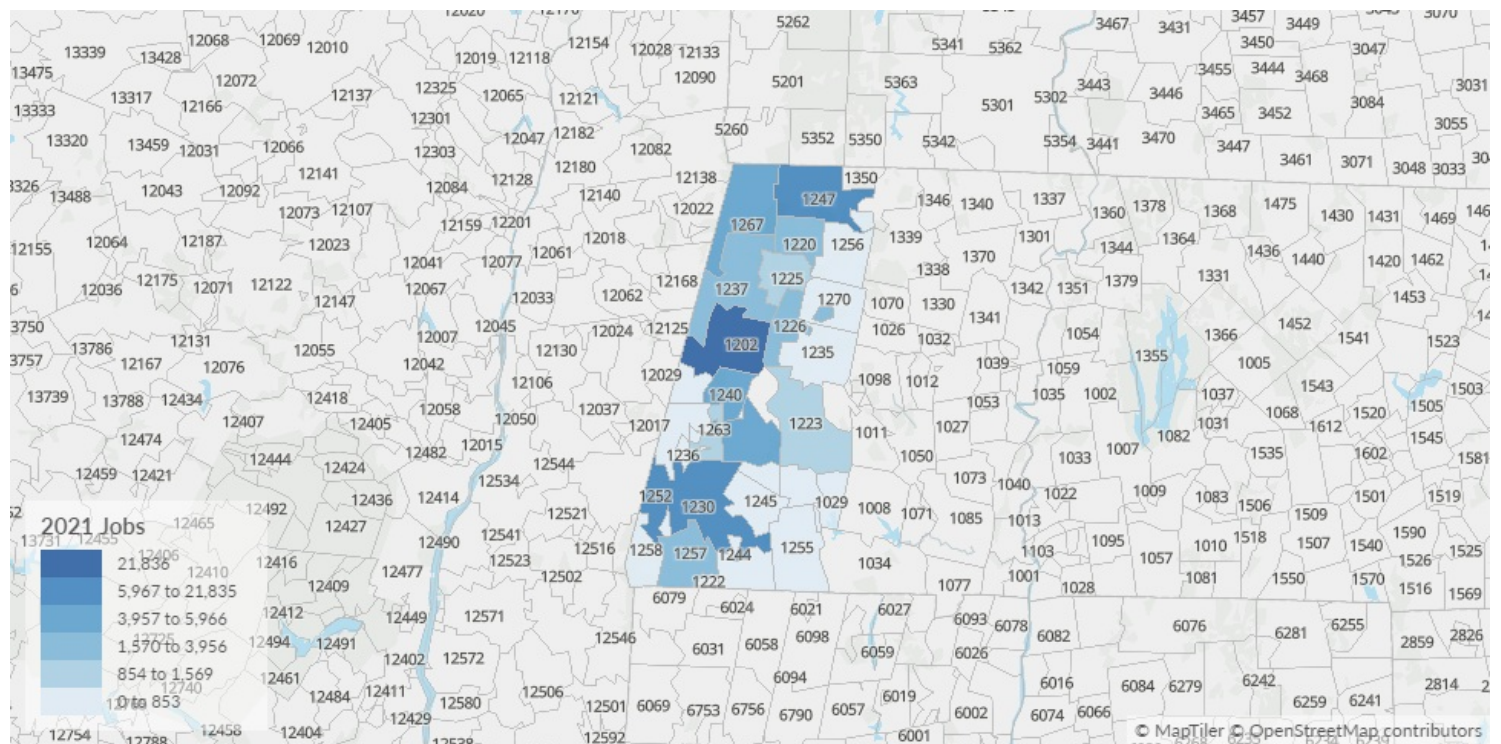

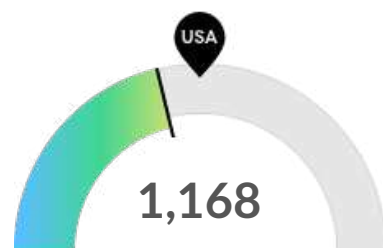

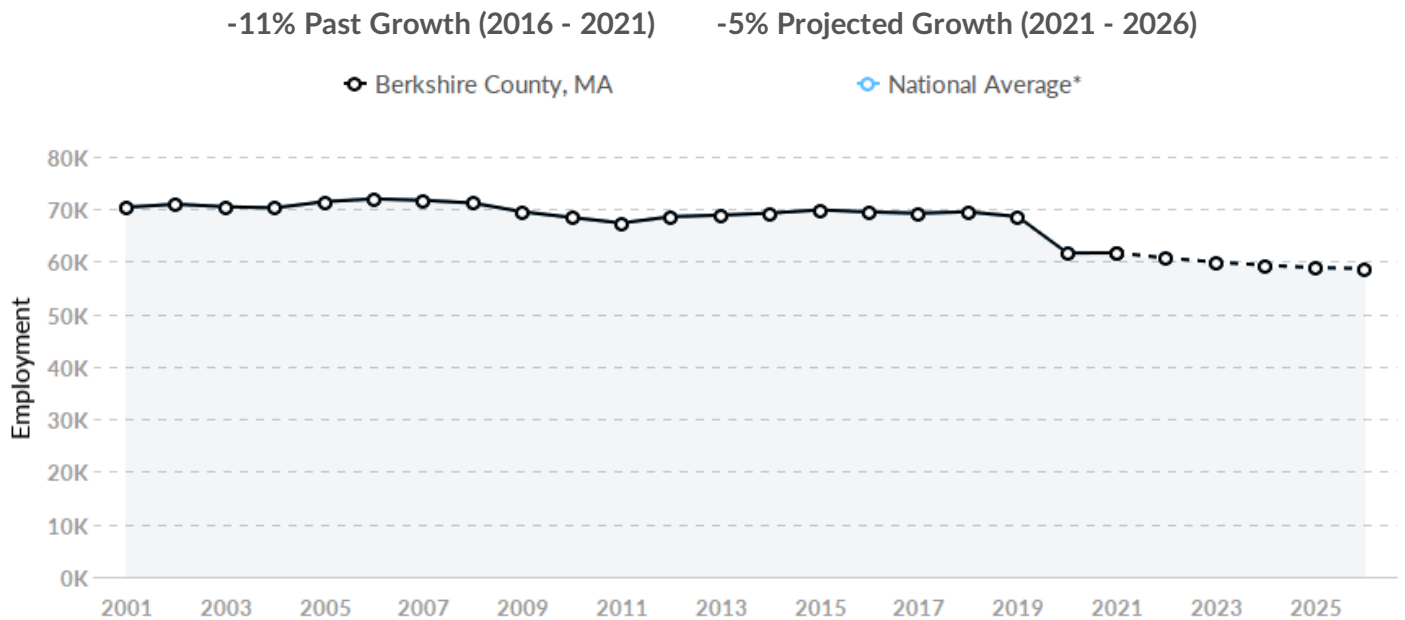

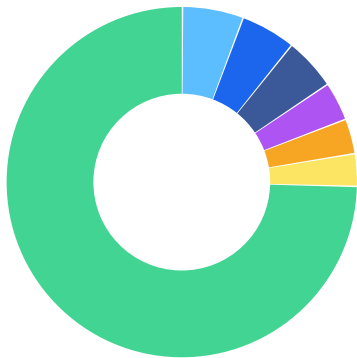
Supply Is About Equal to the National Average

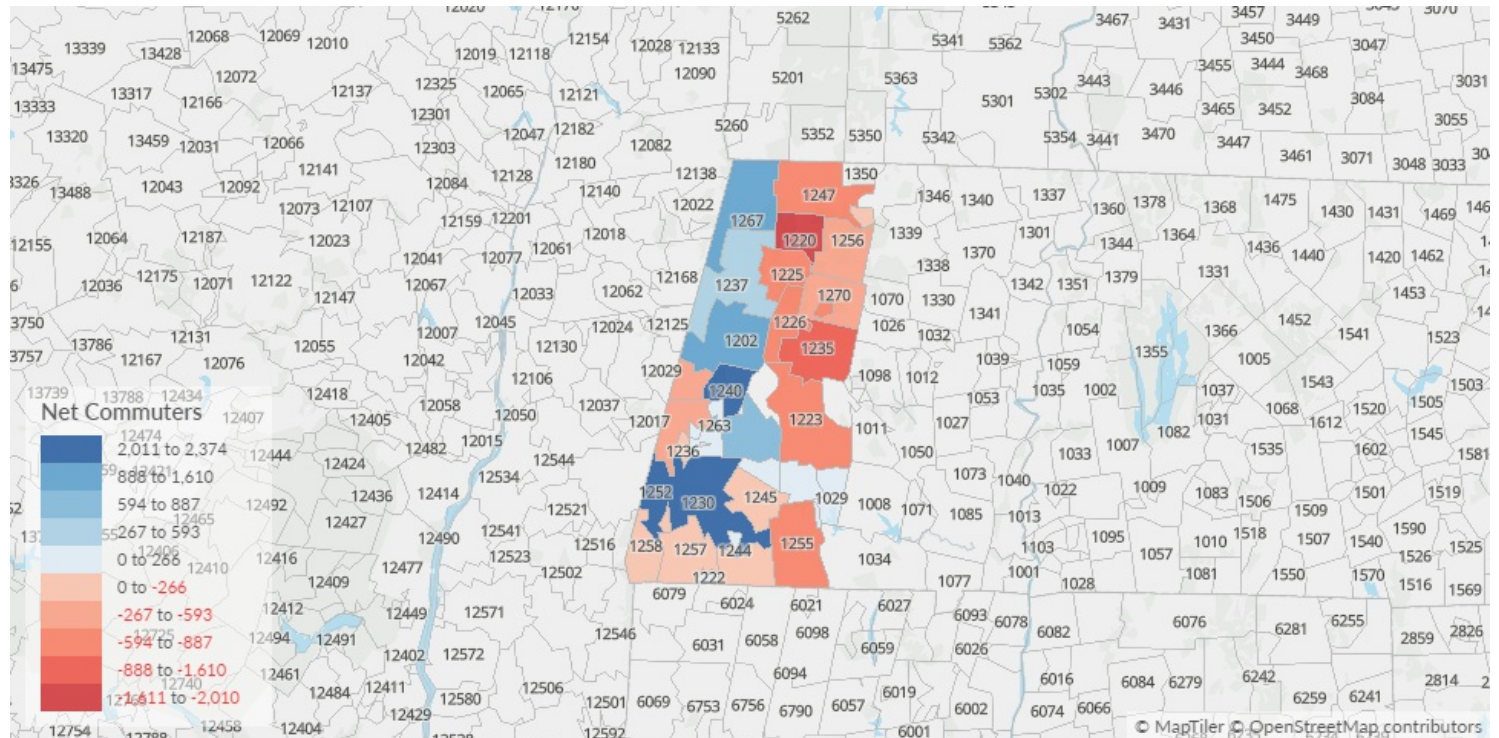

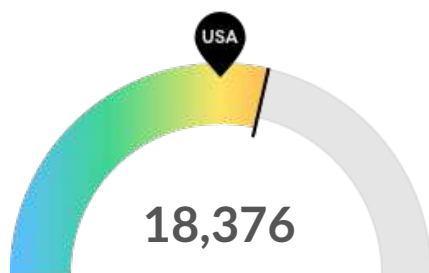

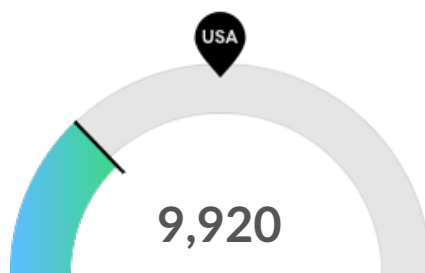

Retirement Risk Is High, While Overall Diversity Is Low



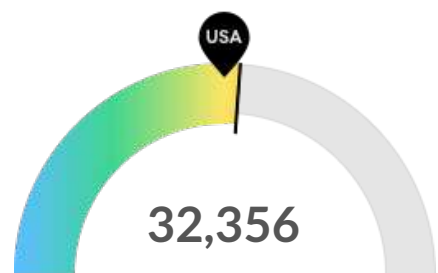
Retiring Soon

Racial diversity is low in Berkshire County, MA. The national average for an area this size is 23,159* racially diverse employees, while there are 9,920 here.



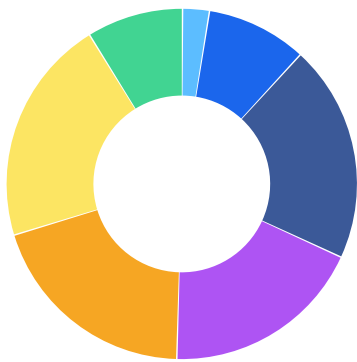

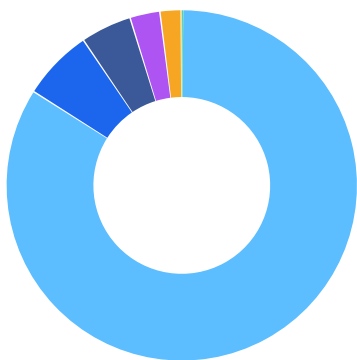

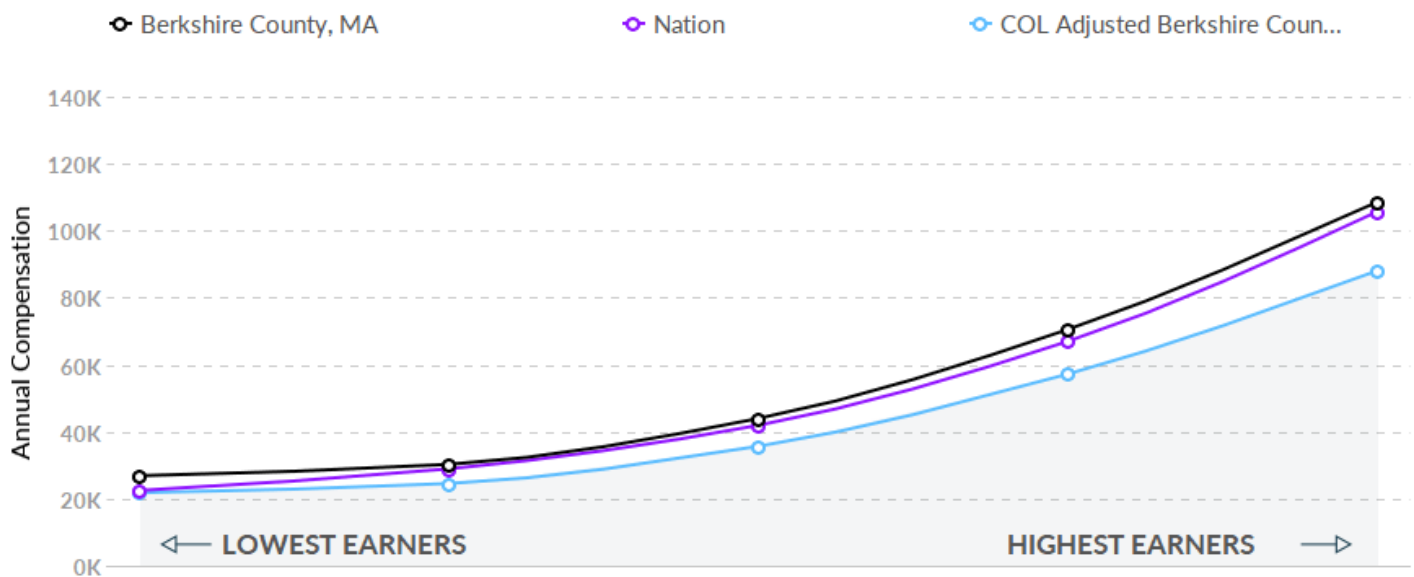

Compensation

Talent Is 5% More Expensive, While the Cost of Living May Make Attraction Difficult

In 2020, the median compensation for your occupations in Berkshire County, MA is \$43,953. Based on the national median wage of \$41,910 for this position, this means you will spend about 5% more to employ your occupations here. However, their actual purchasing power will be 15% less than the national median when we adjust for regional cost of living (which is 23% higher than average). This may make it harder to attract talent to the region at this price.

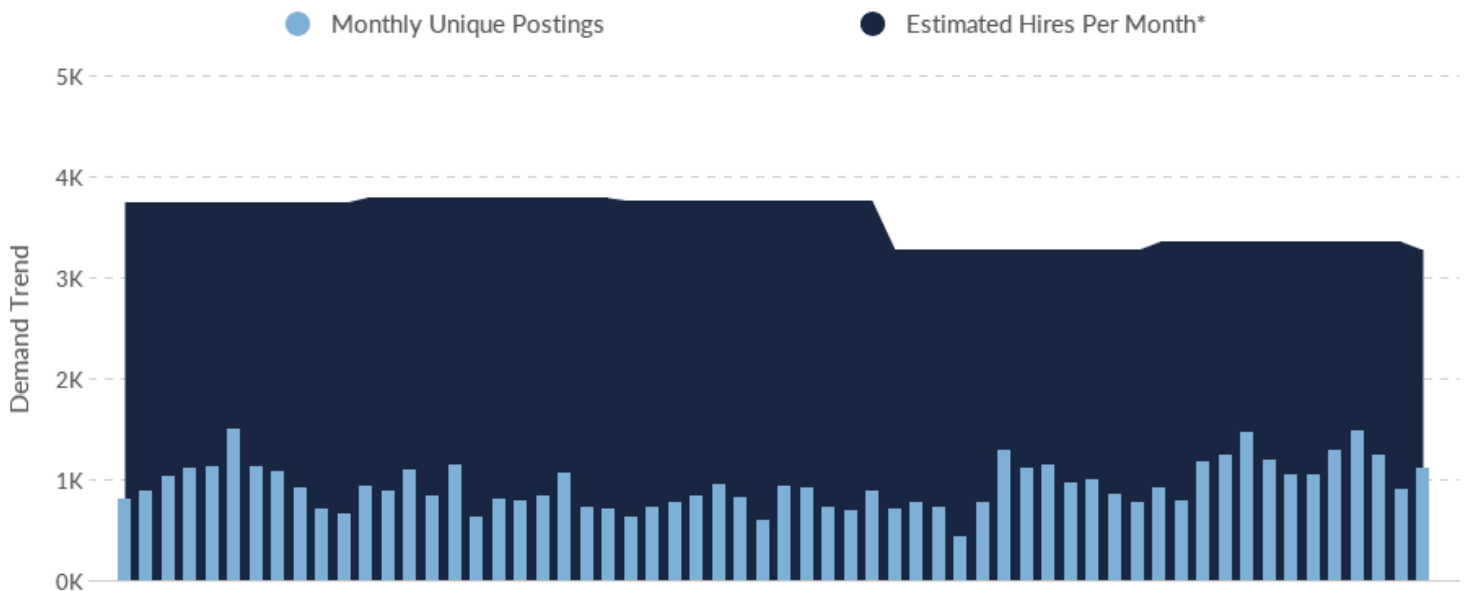

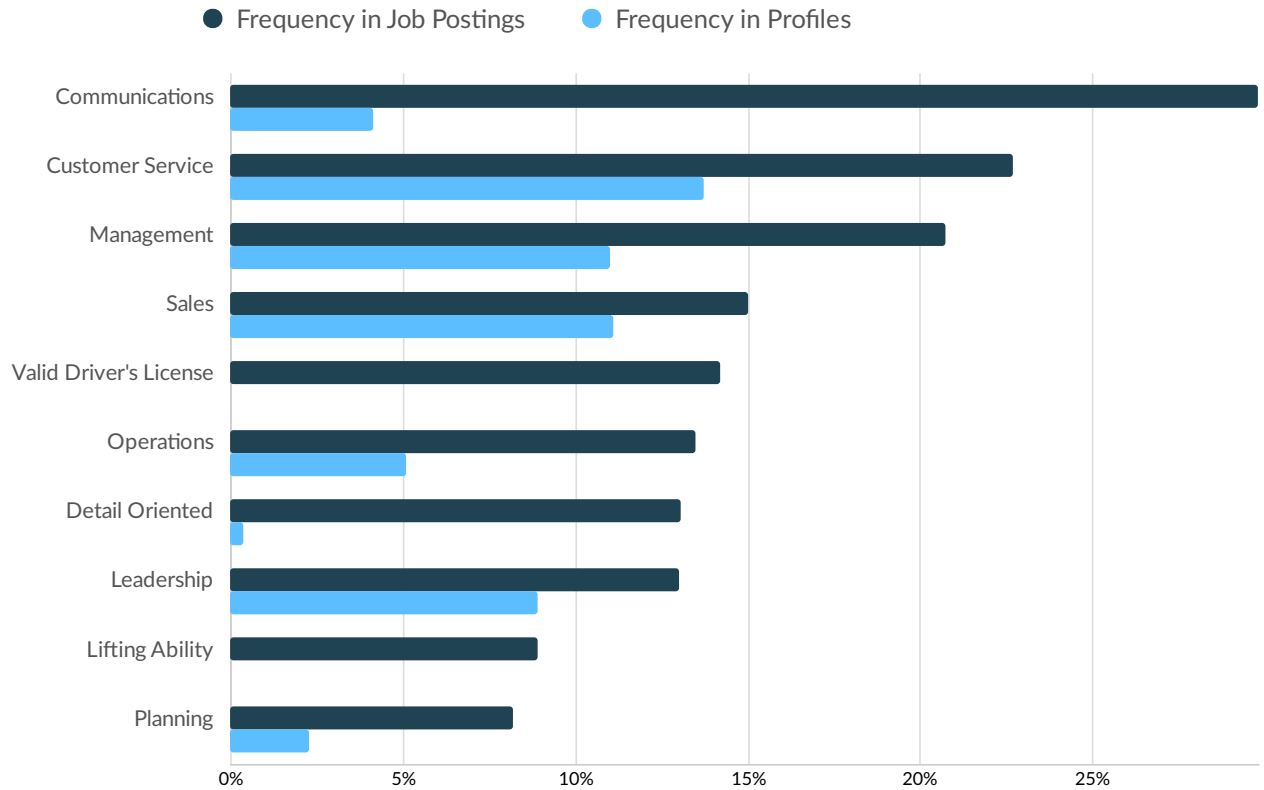

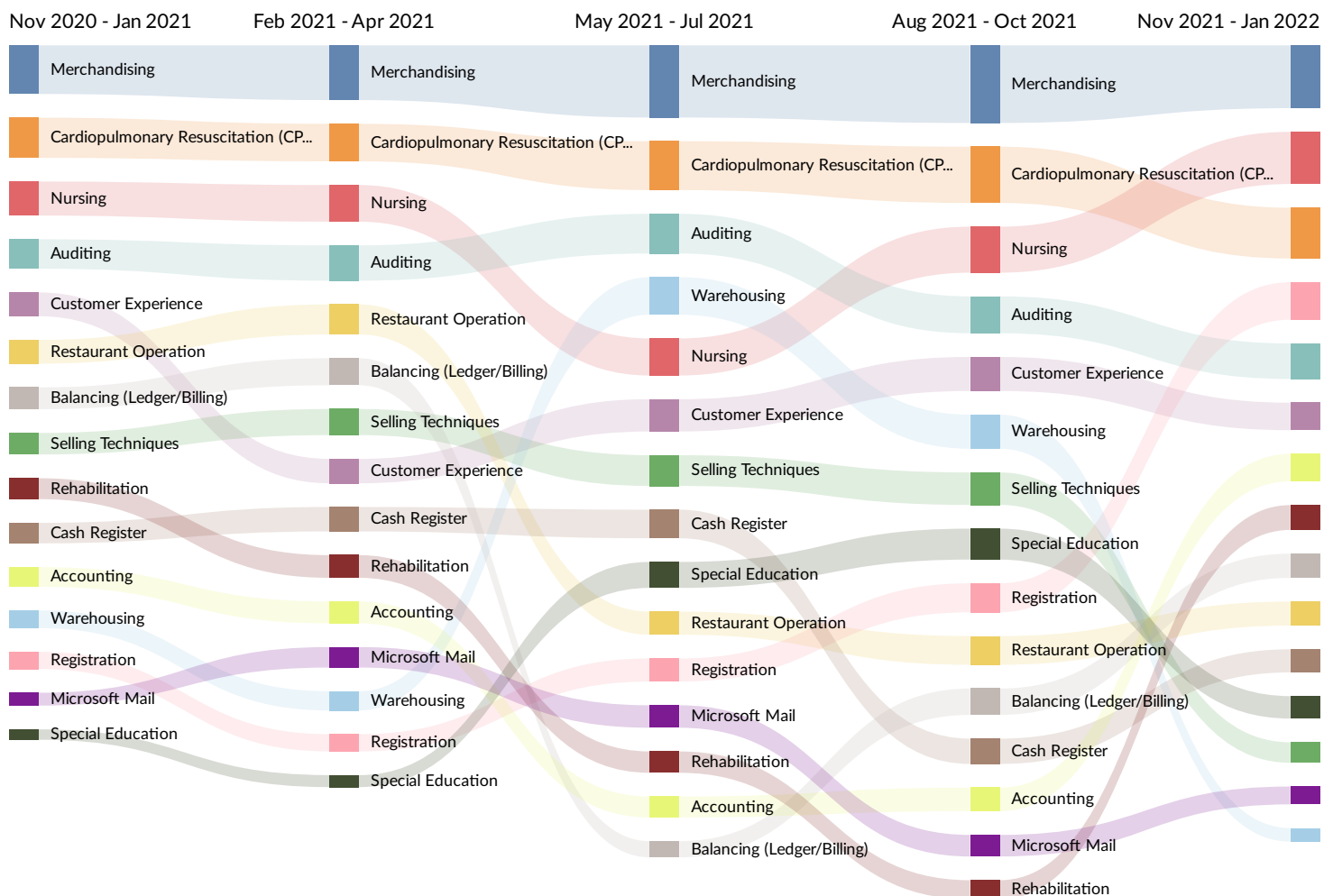
